**665 DECLARATION OF INTEREST** – Mrs M Hutchinson declared an interest with regard to the planning application for Bendle Terrace.

**668 PLANNING MATTERS**

**Minute 644.1 Planning ref: DM/18/0059/FPA – The Crown** – still awaiting the planning decision.

**Minute 668.1 Planning ref: DM/18/01804/FPA – Bail Hill House** – erection of a new workshop, boiler and biomass storage building and detached garage. No objections raised.

**Minute 668.2 Planning ref: DM/18/02015/FPA – 4 Bendle Terrace** - single storey rear extension. Although no objection was raised regarding the proposed extension, the Parish Council requested DCC to clarify with the applicant as to whether the proposed rear extension was to be constructed over a right of way to the adjoining properties in Bendle Terrace.

**669 HIGHWAY MATTERS**

**Minute 29.1 Pothole/Road Survey** – The updated survey was still to be done. Any new potholes continue to be reported to DCC.

The service road to Dale View, there are some potholes that require attention.

**Minute 192.4 Station Road/Bail Hill Road** – Stones and the heap of manure was still on the roadside.

**Minute 400.1 Road Works** – None reported for the Parish.

**Minute 604.2 Railway Line** – Trimming of trees. DCC have requested which trees require trimming.

**Minute 645.1 Trees in Yarker Lane** – To follow up in September.

**Minute 645.2 Parking Issues** – Vehicles again blocking the pavement for pedestrian use at the west end of the Village. A reminder to residents to leave sufficient room for pedestrians to be included in the newsletter.
