648 PLANNING MATTERS

Minute 558.6 Crofts Farm – No information from DCC – Clerk to follow up for information.

649 HIGHWAY MATTERS

Minute 29.1 Potholes/Road Survey – P Thompson reported that he had now equipment that could make a video of the state of the roads, which could be forwarded to DCC.

Minute 192.4 Station Road roadside drains P Thompson stated that some work had been carried out on the road drains as some had been dug out and cleared, but still no work undertaken on the hidden drain.

Minute 385.2 Croft Yokes Lane – Visibility of exit onto the B6277

Clerk reported that DCC had replied to correspondence and DCC felt that the road junction was signed in accordance with best practice.
