Notes of a meeting of Mickleton Parish Council, held on Tuesday, 15 June 2021 at 7pm in Mickleton Village Hall.

21.23 CO-OPTION TO THE PARISH COUNCIL - A ballot was undertaken for the co-option. Ballot 1 - David Shepherd. Ballot 2 - Rowena Fowler.

21.24 MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS HELD ON 18 MAY 2021.

21.24.1 Annual General Meeting - these had been circulated, taken as read, agreed and signed.

21.24.2 Ordinary Meeting - these had been circulated, taken as read, agreed and signed.

21.25 TO CONSIDER ANY MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES, NOT INCLUDED ON THE AGENDA - None.

21.26 FINANCE

21.26.1 Payments - The Parish Council approved the following payment:

21.26.2 Annual Governance and Accountability Return 2020/21 - Clerk reported that all the documentation had been completed and placed on the website.

21.26.3 Purchase of a printer/scanner - P Thompson reported that the Clerk did not have scanning facilities and proposed that the Parish Council purchased a printer/scanner. Details of a printer/scanner were circulated - cost £59.99. Proposed by P Thompson, seconded by G Taffurelli and agreed by the Council, that a printer/scanner be purchased.

21.27 PLANNING MATTERS

21.27.1 Planning Ref: DM/21/01726/FPA - Eastfield Cottage - rear extension - no objections raised.

21.28 HIGHWAY MATTERS

21.28.1 Station Road - Depression in the road, possible culvert damage - Highway Inspector investigated and to monitor.

21.28.2 Croft Yokes Lane - Road edges- Deep drops of the highway edge/grass verge. Grass verges require building up to road level - DCC Inspection carried out and repairs to be carried out.

21.28.3 Removal of rumble strips/B6277 resurface - Clerk reported that there were 5 sets of rumble strips within the village on the B6277. Requested the removal of the 2 sets of rumble strips to the west of the village. Requested date when the B6277 was scheduled for resurface, owing to the poor road surface in parts of the village.

21.28.4 Potholes/other highway issues

Station Road - Request for a salt bin at the junction with the B6277.

Station Road - Road surface damaged by an incident with a tractor.

Road junctions - Visibility being reduced by the roadside vegetation - Clerk to request roadside verges cut, especially at road junctions.

B6277 Lune Bridge - Wall collapse several months ago - Clerk to follow up the repair work.

B6277 Manhole Cover - near Byers Green - manhole cover sunk below road surface - Clerk to follow up.

21,28 PLAYGROUND

21.28.1 ROSPA Inspection - Clerk reported that this was to be carried out in June.

21.29 VILLAGE SEATS

21.29.1 West Pasture Road - Clerk to follow up with N.W.A. regarding their offer to repair/replace the 3 seats.

21.29.2 Highway Seats - Clerk to follow up with DCC regarding their responsibilities towards repair and maintenance of the seats. As this is a very popular tourist area, seats need to be repaired for tourist use.

21.29.3 Replacement seats - The Council to consider whether some of the seats could be replaced with a bench, but it was felt that seats that provided a view of the area should be replaced with a seat.

21.29.4 Bail Hill Road - Clerk to check the damaged rails of the seat and check if replacements were available.

21.30 HISTORICAL BOUNDARY SIGN

Clerk reported that she had emailed the DCC contact that the Yorkshire Devolution Movement had given and was waiting a reply. There was a design fee of £75 quoted, but all this information needs to be discussed with DCC. Clerk to continue to find a DCC contact for information/costings, etc.
